

Qld Cricket Scorers Assoc

Core Responsibilities

1. Operate within the parameters of Cricket Australia and Qld Cricket constitutions
2. Development and training of scorers throughout Queensland. To this end the QCSA will
 - a. Provide open and prompt communication to scorers in relation to scorer development and training throughout Qld
 - b. Initiate regional training opportunities throughout Qld
 - c. Respond appropriately to scorer development and training needs and requests throughout Qld
 - d. Provide an effective development and training model which appropriately services the whole of Qld including
 - i. Identification, training, and accreditation of scorers according to the QCSA Accreditation pathway
 - ii. Providing scorer trainers available to travel to regional centres to conduct training and development
 - iii. Budgeting for this travel
 - iv. Training local personnel to provide basic scorer training to their local scorers as needs arise
3. Maintain a roster of appropriately trained scorers available to score representative level matches in Qld when required
4. Appoint appropriately trained and accredited scorers to representative matches, on request, as per the QCSA appointment bylaws
5. Periodically review, and adjust where necessary, documents and procedures in response to changing needs of scorers throughout Qld
6. Maintain records of membership, accreditation, blue card status of membership
7. Where appropriate and possible, recruit scorers in support of the game of Cricket
