Benefits of membership

1. Access to training, at all levels, appropriate to interest and ability. This is achieved by:
 - a. Highly experienced and accredited QCSA trainers travelling to regional centres to provide training appropriate to regional needs, both initiated by the QCSA and in response to regional requests
 - b. Regional Scorer Communication, Training and Development Coordinators providing basic local training
 - c. A Biennial scorer seminar conducted in Brisbane to which regional scorers are invited with the reimbursement of travel costs
2. Access to a representative scorer pathway for interested scorers involving:
 - a. Accreditation as follows:
 - i. Certificate of Competency (club-based level scoring)
 - ii. Level 1 (initial representative based scoring including domestic competition such as 2nd XI, Shield, Marsh Cup, WNCL and some BBL and WBBL under the supervision of L2)
 - iii. Level 2 (international matches, BBL and WBBL)

NB – this is becoming a growing area for regional centres due to the increasing number of representative matches being assigned to regional areas

3. Access to resources developed by QCSA to support scoring (Scorer Handbook and numerous other resources via the QCSA webpage)
4. Access to highly experienced scorers to answer scoring question which may arise
5. Advocacy for Qld scorers to Qld Cricket
6. Discounted QCSA apparel
