Core business

1. Promote cricket scoring
2. Provide training and support for all scorers in Qld
3. Provide an appropriate scorer accreditation pathway
4. Provide professional scorer services to Qld Cricket, Cricket Australia and other organisations/individuals requiring scoring services in an open and accountable way

Goals

1. Grow QCSA membership and skill level across Qld through
 - a. Supporting, strengthening and growing the Regional Coordinator roles within Qld
 - b. Ongoing promotional activities through clubs, online and by personal contact
2. Improve scorer skill levels through provision/facilitation of appropriate needs responsive training
3. A comprehensive user-friendly website incorporating
 - a. Relevant and current Scorer Association information
 - b. Scorer resources and templates
 - c. Training resources (particularly digital)
 - d. Links to useful and relevant external scorer resources
4. Continued QCSA development of and support to Regional Coordinators in ways responsive to regional needs with priority order
 - a. Mackay
 - b. Sunshine Coast
 - c. Cairns
 - d. Townsville
 - e. Toowoomba/Darling Downs
 - f. Rockhampton
 - g. Gold coast
5. Investigate and initiate an open and accountable scorer payment/reimbursement process

Strategies

1. Immediate initiation of a new webpage platform and migration of QCSA resources and information across
2. Develop and Grants Application process/subcommittee to apply for periodic grant moneys as necessary
3. An immediate review of accreditation processes/tests in response to changing scorer demands
4. Tap into GPS schools for potential scorer development/training/recruitment
5. Continue to focus on regional training through travelling to provide training services in response to regional scorer needs
6. Develop a Relief Scorer pool for access by Brisbane Premier Grade scorers as needed
7. Formation of a digital scorer resource development subcommittee
8. Approve and disseminate a Benefits of Membership document
9. Alter business cards to include a QR code to QCSA

Success Indicators

1. Every Bris Premier cricket club to have 1st and 2nd grade men and 1st grade women scorers
2. At least 1 L2 and a number of L1's (with some specifically trained on scoreboard use) in Mackay, Cairns and Townsville to allow these centres to be self-sufficient for major representative matches
3. Every major regional centre within Qld has a Regional Coordinator
4. Develop comprehensive digital training resources for scoring
